2020 Annual West Salem Police Department Report

Police Chief Jeremy Randall presented a 2020 Annual Report. It has been a goal of the department to be transparent and provide insight into the department. The report indicates the police continue to receive a high demand for services, logging 6,298 case numbers and approximately 8,005 total activity numbers for 2020. Despite the Covid pandemic during 2020, the past year was the department's second highest year in call volume. The report contains a listing of police department staff, an organizational chart, calls for service listing, use of force incidents, and some headlines from 2020. Chief Randall stated an annual report will now continue to be a routine presentation to the Village Board and public.

Planning Commission

President Schumacher reported on the May 5, 2021, Planning Commission meeting. The Commission reviewed an Application for Outdoor Alcoholic Beverage Garden Permit submitted by Tiffany N. Johnson for Whiskey River 54669, LLC. Whiskey River 54669, LLC has submitted plans to utilize and open the previously constructed and approved fenced-in open area adjacent to 153 Leonard Street. Comments were received from Building Inspector William Mandt, Fire Chief Dave Munson, and Police Chief Jeremy Randall. The Commission scheduled a public hearing as required by

Village Ordinances for Wednesday, May 26, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. with a Planning Commission meeting to follow.
