### Minutes

Motion by Trustee Hennessey, seconded by Trustee Twining to approve the minutes of the June 21, 2022, meeting as written. Roll call vote: Unanimous aye. Motion approved.

### Claims

# **Earnest Money Deposit Agreement**

#### Law Enforcement Committee

Trustee Lautz reported on the June 21, 2022, Law Enforcement Committee meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to review for recommendation to the Village Board an Application to Exceed Pet Limit submitted by Jesse Scholl. The applicant resides at 119 Rosewood Lane South. The resident presently owns two, 8-year old neutered male Golden Retrievers. The resident would like to add a 3-month old male Golden Retriever to his home. All three dogs are up to date with their vaccinations, and all three dogs will be kept mainly indoors. The Police Department has received no complaints regarding the applicant's dogs. Village Administrator DeLong received a complaint stating the two dogs Mr. Scholl presently keeps have been barking constantly for years. The complainant stated no one in the neighborhood has reported the barking because they all wish to get along. However, the complainant stated this was a problem for the neighborhood. Mr. Scholl denied that the dogs are allowed to bark. The Committee informed Mr. Scholl allowing dogs to bark is against the Village Ordinances, and he could receive a citation if this is reported and documented. Based on the facts given at this meeting, the Committee recommended approval of the Application.
