## **2022 Approved Boulevard Trees**

### **ROYAL RED MAPLE**

MATURE HEIGHT	35' to 40'
MATURE SPREAD	25'
SHAPE	Broadly oval
FOLIAGE	Maroon red, glossy
FALL FOLIAGE	Insignificant
ZONE	4-7

This Norway Maple selection is similar to "Crimson King", but with a somewhat slower growth rate and what some consider slightly better color. A dense shade tree, it has a straight trunk with a well-shaped canopy. The glossy foliage is an excellent maroon red all season.

### **BRANDYWINE MAPLE – Seedless Male**

MATURE HEIGHT	35' to 40'
MATURE SPREAD	30'
SHAPE	Canopy gradually develops into a rounded oval
FOLIAGE	Green
FALL FOLIAGE	Blaze orange, amazing scarlets and luscious purples
ZONE	4-7

Vivid autumn color display that slowly changes from summer green to blaze orange and deepens into amazing scarlets and purples. Shows superior pest resistance. Great color and shape.

### **RED ROCKET MAPLE**

MATURE HEIGHT	30' to 35'
MATURE SPREAD	10' to 12'
SHAPE	Upright
FOLIAGE	Green
FALL FOLIAGE	Intense red
ZONE	4-7

This strong columnar shaped maple is a perfect fit to brighten up smaller landscapes. Relatively short and upright in stature. It makes an excellent street tree for urban areas. Fiery red foliage glows in the fall. Introduced by the US National Arboretum from Northern Minnesota selection.

### **KARPICK – Male Selection**

MATURE HEIGHT	35' to 40'
MATURE SPREAD	15' to 20'
SHAPE	Dense narrow form becomes oval with age
FOLIAGE	Green
FALL FOLIAGE	Yellow to red
ZONE	3-7

Excellent street tree. Distinct red twigs and green foliage. Yellow to red Fall foliage. Narrow when young, becoming oval with age

### **AMERICAN HORNBEAM**

MATURE HEIGHT	15' to 30'
MATURE SPREAD	20' to 25'
SHAPE	Naturally rounded
FOLIAGE	Green
FALL FOLIAGE	Greens, yellows, reds and even pink. Incredible rainbow of fall colors.
ZONE	3-9

As a street tree, the American Hornbeam should be placed in the category as one of those “Bullet Proof” varieties. Come winter, its blue-gray bark creates a beautiful contrast to the snow in northern climates. Has few, if any, disease or insect pest concerns. The name implies limbs of steel.

### **NORTHERN STRAIN REDBUD**

MATURE HEIGHT	25'
MATURE SPREAD	30'
SHAPE	Rounded form
FOLIAGE	Forest green deciduous foliage which emerges burgundy in spring
FALL FOLIAGE	Buttery yellow
ZONE	4a

Good for planting under power lines. A spectacular and hardy Spring bloomer, with very showy pink to purple flowers held tightly on bare branches in early Spring.
