1. This permit allows the existence of a well to be used for non-potable purpose only. (Non-potable water does not necessarily meet drinking water standards, and, therefore, should not be used for human consumption.) The water line and source should be clearly labeled "non-potable water." This permit in no way certifies the quality of water for any purpose. It will be the sole responsibility of the private well owner to ensure that this water is not used for human consumption.
2. This water will not be discharged into the District's sanitary sewer system.
3. This non-potable supply cannot be interconnected to any potable water lines.
4. It will be the private well owners responsibility to ensure that the well and pumping system complies with any applicable codes, permits, etc., by any County, State or Federal agencies. This should include adequate measures to prevent back siphoning (or reverse flow) into the well under any conditions.
5. It will be the private well owners sole responsibility to ensure that operation of this well does not adversely impact the operation of other private wells in the area.
6. Indemnification and Hold Harmless: Private well owner agrees to Indemnify and hold harmless the Village of West Salem, West Salem Municipal Water Utility and West Salem Sewer Utility and their employees, agents, officers and officials whether hired, appointed or elected, free and harmless from and against any and all judgments, damages, losses, costs, claims, expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fee and costs of defense), suits, demands, actions and/or causes of actions of any kind or any nature which may be sustained or to which they may be exposed by reason of injury or injuries to anyone or of the death or deaths of anyone, or by reason of any personal and/or real property damage, or by reason of any other liability imposed by law upon the above-referenced entities and/or individuals as the result of and/or due to the private well owners and/or the private well owners agents', employees', and contractors' operations and actions taken pursuant to the permission and permit granted by the Water Utility and/or as a result of and/or due to the presence of the private well owner or anyone else on the demised premises for whose acts the private well owner is legally liable, and/or due to the existence of this permission, except such of the foregoing as are due, and to the extent due, to the negligence or intentional act of the Village of West Salem, its employees, agents, officers and officials whether hired, appointed or elected.
7. Release: The private well owner agrees to release the Village of West Salem, West Salem Water Utility and West Salem Sewer Utility and their employees, agents, officers and officials whether hired, appointed or elected, free and harmless from and against any and all judgments, damages, losses, costs, claims, expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of defense), suits, demands, deaths, actions and/or causes of action of any kind or of any nature which may be sustained or to which they be exposed by reason of injury or injuries to anyone or of the death or deaths of anyone, or by reason of any personal and/or real property damage, or by reason of any other liability imposed by law upon the above-referenced entities and/or individuals as the result of and/or due to the private well owner and/or the private well owners agents', employees', and contractors' operations and actions taken pursuant to the permission and permit granted by the Water Utility and/or as a result of and/or due to the presence of the private well owner or anyone else on the demised premises for whose acts the private well owner is legally liable, and/or due to the existence of this permission, except such of the foregoing as are due, and to the extent due, to the negligence or intentional act of the Village of West Salem, its employees, agents, officers, and officials whether hired, appointed or elected.
8. This permit may be revoked at any time for any reason, but generally on the premise to protect the health and well-being of the public.
9. This permit is renewable 5 years from the date of issuance.
10. The information on this form lists facts and conditions of the visible portions of the well at the time of inspection and does not imply or give any kind of guarantee. It is a statement of the opinion of the inspector regarding the compliance of the system at the time of inspection.
