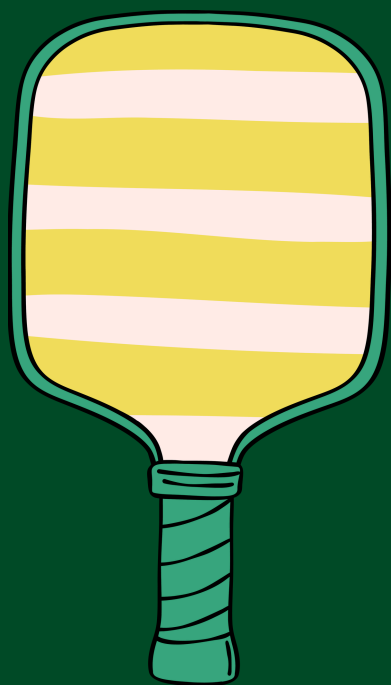


Pickleball Rules

Pickleball Court Rules

- Courts are open for first-come, first-served public use and are not reserved for private or commercial use.
- Courts must be reserved for West Salem Parks & Recreation pickleball programs only.



Pickleball Court Use

- Courts are for pickleball play only. Play at your own risk.
- Be respectful, welcoming and inclusive of players of all skill levels.
- Non-marking tennis shoes required.
- No pets allowed.
- No skateboards, rollerblades, skates, scooters, bicycles, or motorized vehicles.
- No glass, food, alcoholic beverages, or smoking allowed on the courts.
- Paddles, bags, and water bottles allowed on courts.
- Chairs, coolers, or any other personal items are to be kept outside the fence.
- Waiting or watching must be done outside the fence.
- No instruction allowed for financial gain. All organized lessons, leagues, and tournaments must be approved and scheduled through the West Salem Parks & Recreation Department.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

Pickleball Court Rotation Requirements

- Court rotation begins with courts are full and players are waiting.
- Follow the paddle rotation system outlined on the sign located by the paddle holder. One paddle per person.
- Courts cannot be used for drills or practice while others are waiting to play.
- No individual or group may hold a court if players are waiting to play.
